The Denver Developmental Screening Test was introduced in 1967 to identify young children, up to age six, with developmental problems. A revised version, Denver II, was released in 1992 to provide needed improvements. The purpose of the tests is to identify young children with developmental problems so that they can be referred for help. The tests address four domains of child development: personal-social, fine motor and adaptive, language, and gross motor. They are meant to be used by medical a

The Denver Developmental Screening Test (DDST) is a test designed for use in initial screening of children to identify those with developmental problems so they can be referred for more precise evaluation and intervention, if appropriate.

What is the Denver Developmental Screening Test?

DDST-II is a formal developmental screening tool that assesses children from birth to 6 years of age. First it was standardized on 1036 children (543 boys and 493 girls) from 2 weeks old to 6/4 years of age in Denver, Colorado as DDST. Then in 1992 it is revised and restandardized on 2096 children and is known as DDST-II.

Denver Developmental Screening Test: The Denver Developmental Screening Test (DDST) is a widely used assessment for examining children 0-6 years of age as to their developmental progress. The name "Denver" reflects the fact that this screening test was created at the University of Colorado Medical Center in Denver.

Definiton of Denver Developmental Screening Test

Child must perform standing broad jump over width of test sheet (8 1/2 inches). Tell child to walk heel within 1 inch of toe. Tester may demonstrate. Child must walk 4 consecutive steps. Type of Measure: The DENVER II is a measure of developmental problems in young children. It was designed to assess child performance on various age-appropriate tasks and compares a given child's performance to the performance of other children the same age.

The normative data from 2096 children does not represent the national population with the following misrepresentations: overrepresented Hispanic infants, under represented African-American Children, and disproportion of mother's education greater than 12 years.
