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The results of diagnostic assessments inform instruction and intervention. Diagnostic assessments can be formal standardized tests of children's component reading and language abilities or informal measures such as criterion-referenced tests and

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informal reading inventories. Not all children need this kind of in-depth reading assessment, which is most important for struggling and at-risk readers.

There are three major types of assessments that provide

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teachers and schools with important information on student reading progress and needs: Diagnostic, summative, and formative. Diagnostic assessments are measures of students' current knowledge and skills and can be used to identify a suitable program of learning. They are administered before instruction occurs to assist in identifying appropriate instruction and interventions.
