Analysis of fire station locations efficiency using GIS ...

GIS assigns each census block to its closest fire station, as indicated by the red lines (keeping in mind that actual drive time is calculated over the street network). Blocks that are more than four minutes from a station or that have no population, such as in a business park, are not assigned.
