If you see your child acting aggressively - hitting, biting, smacking or spitting - you know it's time to step in and stop the behavior immediately. Put the child on a time-out (the rule of thumb is one minute of time out for each year old your child is) or send them to a calm down spot to cool off for a few minutes.
