The Kaufman Speech to Language Protocol (K-SLP) is the method at the heart of all of the KCC's speech and language programs. It is a treatment approach for children with childhood apraxia of speech (CAS), other speech sound disorders, and expressive language challenges. The K-SLP focuses upon the child's speech-motor skills, shaping the consonants, vowels and syllable shapes/gestures from what they are capable of producing toward higher levels of speech-motor coordination, giving them a ...

KAUFMAN APPROACH FOR APRAXIA. The Kaufman Speech to Language Protocol (K-SLP) is a treatment approach developed by Nancy Kaufman for childhood apraxia of speech (CAS) and other speech sound disorders to help children become vocal communicators. It is based on the fact that speech production is a fine motor skill and that full words are often difficult to master for children who struggle to speak.

The Kaufman Treatment Kit 1 is considered the basic level, and is geared toward children between the ages of 2 and 8. It targets the synthesis of basic sounds, such as /m, t, b, d, h, n, w, and p/. The Kaufman Treatment Kit 2 is considered the advanced level, and is geared toward children between the ages of 4 and 10.

Annual Goal: Alex will acquire the ability to plan and sequence alternating vowels in V, CV, and CVC combinations. (Note these are to be done as fun speech drills for 5 minutes each day, if possible two times a day, before he goes to school as well as in therapy.)

The goal of intervention for a child with apraxia is to enable the child to gain volitional control of his/her articulators in order to produce age-appropriate, co-articulated, intelligible speech (co-articulation refers to the way we talk when we connect our words together in a speech-melody, rather than pronouncing each word individually).

Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) - Apraxia Kids

The goal of this skill set is to improve prosody skills in children with CAS, including rate, pitch, and volume. Attending to Variations in pitch, rate, and volume: Expose the child to variations in pitch, rate, and volume and pair these variations with words to describe them. Opposites such as fast/slow, high/low, and loud/quiet should be introduced.

What to Work on in Speech Therapy for Children with CAS ...

Aids in the diagnosis and treatment of childhood apraxia of speech. The Kaufman Speech Praxis Test (KSPT) is a norm-referenced, diagnostic test assisting in the identification and treatment of childhood apraxia of speech. Easy to administer and score, KSPT measures a child's imitative responses to the clinician, identifies where the speech system is breaking down, and points to a systematic course of treatment.

The target audience for the Kaufman Kit Basic Level will usually be children between the ages of two and six. The pictures on the cards were designed with those ages in mind. These cards will be most useful for children who are struggling with producing simple syllable shapes and need to focus on the early emerging consonants /p, b, m, t, d, n, h/.
