Must hold certification in orthopedic surgery from the AOBOS. Must have been in the active practice of Orthopedic Sports Medicine for at least two years. During years 2018-2022, any individual who has not completed an Orthopedic Sports Medicine Fellowship, but who otherwise meets the certification criteria, may apply to sit for the examination.

### **Orthopaedic Sports Medicine and Shoulder Surgery Fellowship**

Orthopaedic surgery has been one of the most difficult residencies to obtain, resulting in a considerable number of unmatched fourth-year medical students annually. In 2012, a total of 1046 applicants (845 fourth-year medical students in the United States) vied for 682 residency positions in orthopaedic surgery .

Verification that candidate completed the CORRE examination with a minimum passing score at or above the 10th percentile. Letter of recommendation from a D.O. with an active practice to be included with residency application. (letter must indicate that applicant understands osteopathic philosophy)
