Morse decided that an idea alone cannot be patented, but only when it is put to use. In 1894, Schillinger v. United States case established that no one can bring a patent infringement case against the U.S. government. In 1895, a patent case regarding an incandescent lamp showed the need for detailed patents and invalidated any that are too vague.
