Two years ago, researchers explored long-term effects of SEL from 6 months to 18 years after students from kindergarten through high school experienced SEL teaching, through a meta-analysis of 82 school-based universal SEL programs involving 97,406 students. 3 Those students showed stronger social-emotional skills and attitudes, more positive social behaviors, and greater academic success, an average of 3.75 years afterward.
