Creativity has been defined in many ways but one feature that is always mentioned is novelty (Sternberg, 1988).That is, the product of a creative endeavor should always be relatively unlike what has been done before.Novelty presupposes that creativity is a process that allows the mind to work out new solutions to problems, to be innovative and to be original.
