AUSTIN -- The Railroad Commission of Texas issued a total of 395 original drilling permits in October 2020 compared to 971 in October 2019. Texas Administrative Code

In the event that a generator or transporter disposes, without proper authorization, of wastes regulated by the RRC at a facility permitted by the TCEQ, the RRC is responsible for enforcement actions against the generator or transporter, and the TCEQ is responsible for enforcement actions against the disposal facility.

Complex sites include those that occur in sensitive environmental areas as defined by 16 TAC3.91 (SWR 91) and may require site specific cleanup levels based on risk. Additionally, Operator Cleanup Program staff may be involved in the review of cases where the source of contamination is uncertain. Sites are referred to the Site Remediation Section by the Railroad Commission of Texas (Commission) District Offices, Commission Legal Enforcement Section and directly from industry.

The Railroad Commission is part of Texas' plural executive. Commissioners are elected by voters, not appointed. Because there are three Commissioners serving rotating six-year terms, it is the only statewide executive position that is on Texas' general election ballot every two years.

Texas flaring intensity is well below that of comparable countries according to the World Bank. It is worth noticing that during the RRC's recent prorating discussions a substantial number of industry players advocated for curtailment of flaring. The Railroad Commission.
